

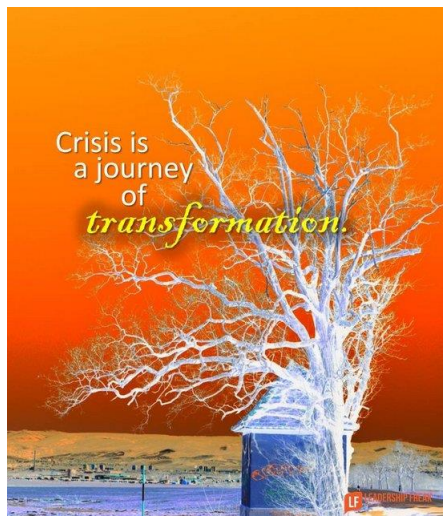


Leading Through Times of Crisis
