

## **Blueprint Reading for the Beginner**

This course is designed specifically for the "beginner blueprint reader" and/or individuals who have never taken a mechanical drawing course. This course employs a blended learning curriculum which includes instructor-led lectures/discussions, demonstration models to enhance learning, supplemental videos, and intensive in-class, hands-on exercises involving reading and interpreting blueprints. CAD and solid modeling are discussed and put into context, however this is a foundational course. Students will learn fundamentals which may stimulate a desire to pursue CAD or solid modeling as a follow-on course.

## **Course Objectives:**

This course will provide students with a solid foundation in "the language of industry" and an introductory level of competency in beginning blueprint reading. Students will be prepared for employment involving blueprint reading and for further study.

## Instructional Guidance Checklist:

- Foundational presentation/discussion (a new way of thinking; alphabet of lines; isometric and orthographic projection; scale; tolerance);
- Between twenty and thirty-five hands-on exercises (to include models as needed), depending on course length;
- Two "instructor assessments" (check-up quizzes) to ascertain instructor's effectiveness in conveying material before advancing to next level of the subject.

Target Audience: Students who have had minimal or no exposure to mechanical drawing or blueprint reading
